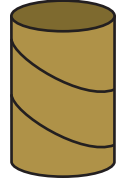


MINIBEAST HOTEL

TOILET ROLL TUBE




SOME STICKS




SCRAP PAPER


Method:
